What are the recognition's which we observe in the field of Emergency Medical Services?

- **Years of Service Award**

The EMS Provider who achieves one year, five, ten, fifteen, twenty, twenty-five or more will receive a certificate of recognition from the EMS Program.

- **Department Celebrations**

EMS and Fire Departments with milestone years of service to their community of twenty, twenty-five, thirty years or more will receive a certificate of “Special Community Service In EMS,” from the EMS Program.

- **Special Recognition Awards**

EMS and Fire Departments and/or their members who accomplished a special event for the State of Nebraska in EMS, or their own Department will receive a certificate from the EMS Program.

- **We Delivered A Baby**

A Baby Stork pin will be awarded to those EMS providers who assisted mom in the delivery of a newborn while in their care, at home or en route to the hospital. The Department will receive a special certificate from the EMS Program.

- **Code Save Award**

Presented to those EMS providers who saved a life during CPR and/or defibrillation.
